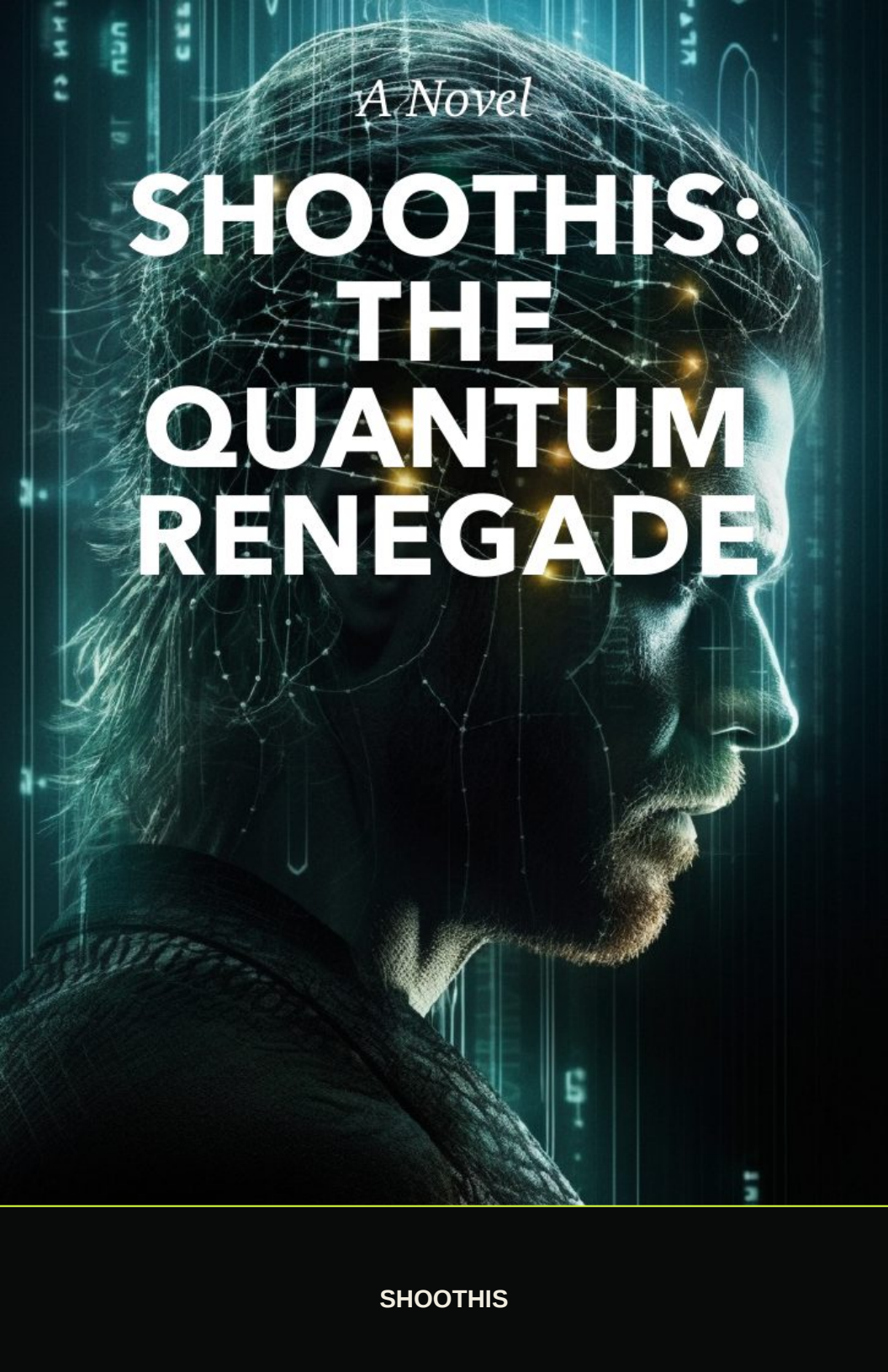

These friends called themselves the 'Flowerers,' an idyllic throwback to a time when life bloomed naturally, without the relentless churn of data and pixels. They preferred

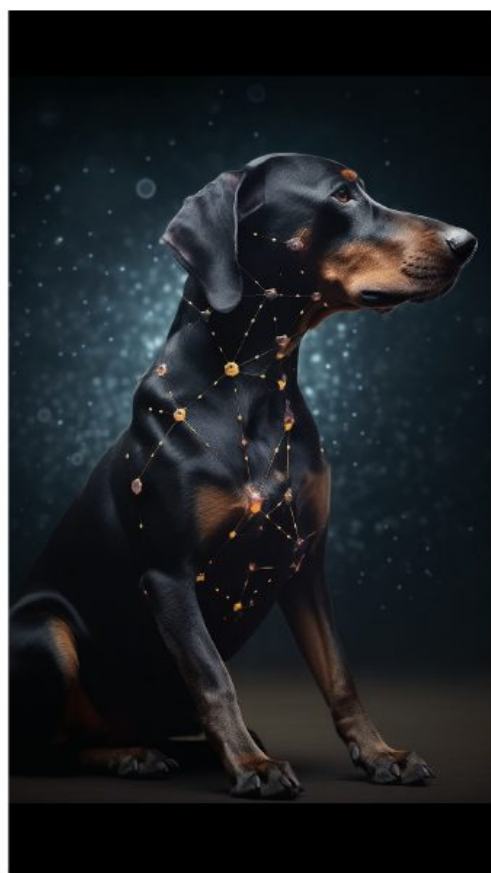

@Primrose: 'Interesting, Petunia. Anonymity would be key.'

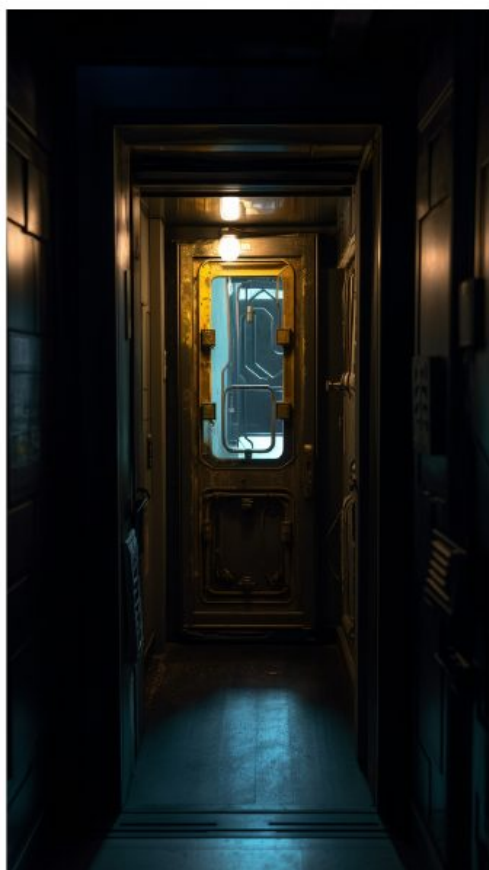
@Aster: 'We'll need to ensure it's undetectable. Any disruption in the qbit flow could draw attention.'

Little did the postman know, these weren't just any pictures. This was the

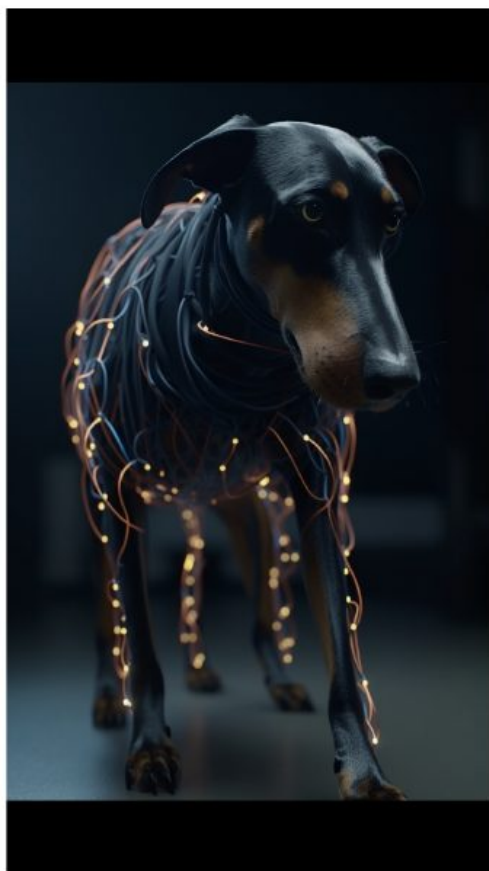

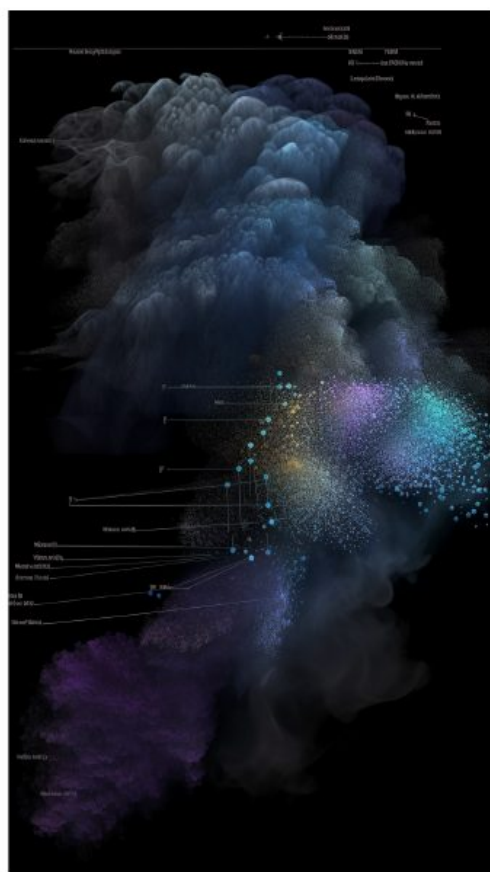

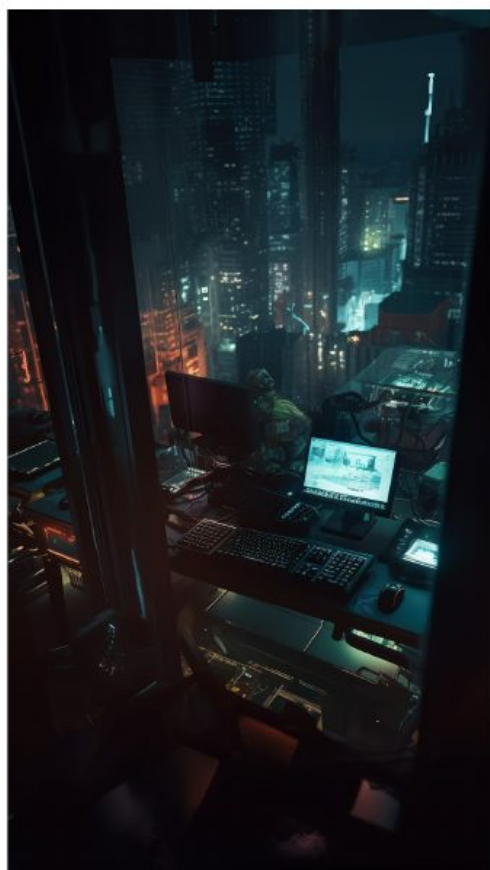
